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PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that on August 13, 2012 at 8:30 a.m., or another date and/or time as may be scheduled by the Court, in Department 22 of the above-referenced Court located at 1221 Oak Street, Fourth Floor, Oakland, CA 94612, Defendant Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc. ("Watchtower") will and hereby does move the Court pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 629 for an order for judgment notwithstanding the verdict ("JNOV") as to Plaintiff's claim for punitive damages on the grounds, including but not limited to that (1) there was no clear and convincing evidence of malice to support the award of punitive damages, and (2) the award of punitive damages is unconstitutional because Plaintiff's intent was to change Watchtower's national policy.
