
Dear brother:

If, based on it, they do not give you 4-D, then you will have some basis for argument, and then you can file such additional material as you then have when you appear for the personal appearance. I return one of the copies of your letter of October 17 that you sent to me. You might correct the mis-spelling in the first line of paragraph five on page 1 and last word in the first line of paragraph two on page 2.

Having in mind that Selective Service 'harps' on the administering of rites and ceremonies, you might be prepared with written and oral information on this subject as suggested in the Counsel memorandum, copy of which is enclosed.
