Dear brothers:

Thank you very much for the enclosed letter of September 20, 1957. The reason I am returning it is because there seems to be an error in the first paragraph. It says that I have been pioneering "since October 1, 1952"

According to my records I was appointed Vacation pioneer May 1, 1952 with the Grand Coulee Congregation of Jehovah's witnesses. On June 30 I was appointed Vacation pioneer with the Moses Lake Congregation. September 1, 1952 I received a Regular pioneer assignment with the Moses Lake Congregation and on May 20, 1953 an assignment with the Ephrata Congregation, where I am working now.

My "CERTIFICATE FOR PIONEER" (issued Dec. 31, 1952) states I was appointed a pioneer on May 1, 1952. In order that this "TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN" may be in harmony with this and other draft board records I am returning it so that if there is an error it may be corrected.
