#### MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

California Rule of Court 9.40(a) provides that "[a] person who is not a member of the State Bar of California but who is a member in good standing of and eligible to practice before the bar of any United States court or the highest court in any state, territory, or insular possession of the United States, and who has been retained to appear in a particular cause pending in a court of this state, may in the discretion of such court be permitted upon written application to appear as counsel *pro hac vice*, provided that an active member of the State Bar of California is associated as attorney of record."

Mario F. Moreno, Associate General Counsel for Watchtower, coordinates all of the defense litigation for Watchtower, including appeals, in the United States. Following entry of Judgment adverse to Watchtower in the underlying trial court matter before the Alameda Superior Court, it has become necessary for Watchtower to pursue its appellate remedies with this Court, and it desires to do so with Mr. Moreno's input and assistance. However, as Mr. Moreno is not yet admitted before the Court of Appeal and Mr. Moreno's participation and appearance will be required on behalf of Watchtower throughout the course of this appeal, Watchtower respectfully files this *pro hac vice* motion pursuant to California Rule of Court 9.40, subd. (c)(2). Proper and timely notice of this motion has been given to all parties in this case and to the State Bar of California at its San Francisco address.

As set forth in the attached declaration of Mario F. Moreno, all the requirements of Rule 9.40 have been met by the declarant. Accordingly, Watchtower

respectfully moves this Court to permit Mario F. Moreno, Associate General Counsel for Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc., to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this appellate matter in association with Jon R. Williams, Esq., an active member of the State Bar of California and Certified Appellate Specialist who also serves as appellate counsel of record for Watchtower in this appeal.

#### **DECLARATION OF MARIO F. MORENO**

- I, Mario F. Moreno, declare as follows:
- 1. I am an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of New York. I serve as in-house counsel and Associate General Counsel for Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc. ("Watchtower"), the Appellant/Defendant in this appeal. I have been assigned by Watchtower's General Counsel, Philip Brumley, to represent Watchtower in this case.
- 2. I make this application for permission to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Watchtower pursuant to Rules 9.40 and 8.54 of the California Rules of Court.
- 3. I am not a resident of California nor am I regularly engaged in the practice of law in California. My office address is Watchtower Bible and Tract Society of New York, Inc., Legal Department, 100 Watchtower Drive, Patterson, NY 12563. My telephone number is (845) 306-1000.
- 4. I am a resident of New York. My residential address is 2721 Route 22, Patterson, NY 12563-2228.
- 5. I am admitted to practice law in the jurisdictions of Arizona, Connecticut, and New York. I was admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona and all other courts in the State of Arizona on October 13, 1979. I was admitted to practice before the District Court for the District of Arizona on September 5, 1980. I was admitted to practice before the Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit on September 7, 1982. I was admitted to practice before the Supreme

Court of the State of Connecticut and all other courts in the State of Connecticut on June 10, 1994. I was admitted to practice before the Court of Appeals of the State of New York and all other courts in the State of New York on December 7, 1994. I was admitted to practice before the District Court, Southern District of New York, on October 14, 2003.

- 6. I am currently in good standing and eligible to practice in all courts to which I am admitted.
  - 7. I am not currently suspended or disbarred in any court.
- 8. In the preceding two years, I have applied to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in two cases in California. In the first case, *Dorman v. La Jolla Church*, San Diego Superior Court, Case Number 37-2010-00092450-CU-PO-CTL, my unopposed *pro hac vice* application was filed with the Superior Court on or about May 6, 2011. After the Superior Court granted my application, I was admitted *pro hac vice* on or about June 3, 2011. In the second case, *Rivera, et al. v. Pacific Beach Church, et al.*, San Diego Superior Court, Case Number 37-2011-00096950-CU-PO-CTL, my unopposed *pro hac vice* application was filed with the Superior Court on or about November 4, 2011. After the Superior Court granted my application, I was admitted *pro hac vice* on or about December 16, 2011.
- 9. Watchtower has also employed as their appellate counsel in this matter the firm of Boudreau Williams LLP, by Jon R. Williams, Esq., a Certified Specialist in Appellate Law (State Board of Legal Specialization). Mr. Williams is an active member of the State Bar of California.

10. Concurrently with the filing of this Application, I submit the required fee of \$50.00 along with a copy of this Application to the State Bar of California.
