Also find a copy of "SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION BEFORE THE LOCAL BOARD DECEMBER 3, 1957" which I prepared after the board meeting. I am sending a copy of this to the board for inclusion in my file. A frendiler atmosphere prevailed at this meeting and I presented all the points I could remember, However I don't think a IV-D will result as I suspect that the local board has the attitude of 'let the appeal board do it'. The board showed it self to be unfimilar with court cases we have won and the points we won them on.

I have not yet received a classification card on the results of this Dec. 3 meeting but if the decision is not IV-D I will appeal to the appeal board with a statement of appeal a mentioned in 'Procedure' page 18 and "Appeal Statement" on page 4 of the 'Memorandum' of July 1954.
